All people on the club premises and course that are not from the same household are to maintain social distancing of 2 metres unless contingency measures are in place which include not sitting opposite each other, face protection masks are worn. Aim to arrive no more than 10 minutes before your allocated Tee Time, unless you are going to practice. No picking up "lost" golf balls. No touching or removing the flag poles on the greens. No raking bunkers unless you have your own rake with you. Unless from the same household:- Always remain at least 2 metres from others while at the golf club. There should be NO physical contact between people on the golf course. No hand shaking. No counter signing of score cards. No sharing OF ANY equipment or property including golf balls. No sharing of any food or drinks. No touching or handling other people's belongings. Endeavour to tee off from a different position to those you are playing with. Best practice Hygiene requirements (handwashing etc.) are to be adhered to. Hand washing facilities are located in the toilet block adjacent to the 10th tee. When open the halfway house will have sanitiser for your use. Persons showing signs of COVID-19 infection are to leave the golf club immediately you feel unwell with the symptoms of Covid – 19. Follow NHS guidelines for self-isolating. Contact the club to inform who has left the golf club with the symptoms of the virus. Bring your own wipes and use them for yourself only. 	1	4	L
