

Lady Captain's Report 8th May 2015

There was a Management Meeting on the 29th April which I did not attend as I was away.

1. Re the development of the course, the planning application was turned down but plans are still on-going. Andy Davis, who used to work for Boston Council, appears to be leading the issue.
2. Apparently, subscription fees are down this year, although membership has increased to 472 (from 413)
3. Andy Davis has been tasked with carrying out a strategy review of the club and it's future.
